

2011-2012 PSAT, SAT I, SAT II, and ACT Information

Dear UNCSA High School Students:

You are responsible for registering yourself on-line for the SAT I or II at www.collegeboard.org. The University of North Carolina School of the Arts will be a private SAT test center for our high school students on the following two dates: **October 1, 2011** and **January 28, 2012**. (Note that the registration deadline for the October test date is September 19, 2011!) Register now and reserve your seat for a UNCSA SAT administration. If you want to take the SAT at UNCSA in October or January, and the College Board won't accept your test center request for some reason, please exit on-line registration and let the Guidance Counselor at UNCSA know before you submit your registration for another test center. The College Board will charge you an additional fee to switch your test center back to UNCSA once you've already submitted your registration. The Guidance Counselor, Mr. Brock Snyder, will be able to intervene on your behalf. Students who need additional assistance should contact him at snyderb@uncsa.edu or 336-770-1320.

If you plan to take the SAT at UNCSA in October or January, please use both of the following codes where requested during on-line registration. **YOU MUST USE THESE TWO CODES IN ORDER TO BE CORRECTLY ASSIGNED TO UNCSA:**

UNCSA test center code: 34-858 UNCSA School Code: 344438

If you prefer to take the SAT closer to your own home (for example on the March 10, 2012 test date, which is during UNCSA's spring break), be sure that you still use the UNCSA School Code above to insure that your scores are sent to UNCSA.

If you plan to take the SAT in Winston-Salem at a time other than October or January, and you want transportation provided by UNCSA, you must register to take the test at **Parkland High School**, a public high school located about two miles from the UNCSA campus. The test center code for Parkland is **34-855**, but you should still use the UNCSA *School Code* above to insure that your scores are sent to UNCSA rather than Parkland. **Once you have been assigned to Parkland, you are responsible for signing up for transportation in the Student Life Office in the Hanes Student Commons Building (tel. 336-770-1476).** The campus transportation office will provide transportation to the Parkland High School test center only. Testing sites fill up quickly, so register early. If you are assigned to a test center other than UNCSA or Parkland, you will be responsible for your own transportation.

The **PSAT** will be given at UNCSA on **Saturday, October 15, 2011**. Registration for the PSAT will be handled through the UNCSA High School Academic Program office beginning September 21, and Mr. Snyder will speak with all sophomores and juniors in their English classes about preparing and signing up for the PSAT. There is on on-line registration available for the PSAT.

2011-2012 ACT Information

You are responsible for registering yourself on-line for the ACT at www.ACTstudent.org. UNCSA does not offer ACT administrations on campus. See below for information on choosing a local test center.

If you plan to take the ACT in Winston-Salem and you want transportation provided by UNCSA, you must register to take the test at **Parkland High School**, a public high school located about two miles from the UNCSA campus. The ACT test center code for Parkland is **181690**, but you should still use the UNCSA *School Code* above (the same as for the SAT) to insure that your scores are sent to UNCSA rather than Parkland.

Once you have been assigned to Parkland, you are responsible for signing up for transportation in the Student Life Office in the Hanes Student Commons Building (tel. 336-770-1476). The campus transportation office will provide transportation to the Parkland High School test center only. Testing sites fill up quickly, so register early. If you are assigned to a test center other than UNCSA or Parkland, you will be responsible for your own transportation. For additional information, please visit www.ACTstudent.org.
